Give Inc Women's Fund was launched in July 2025.

It is a new collaboration between the Give Inc giving circle and the Community Foundation for Northern Ireland's Women's Fund.

Give Inc, Ireland's first giving circle, was established in Summer 2008. The idea is a simple one.

A group of women pool their funds, donating £1 a day.

They used the money to support mainly women and children in our communities with small grants.

The Women's Fund was established in Spring 2012 to assist women to create and develop new opportunities in their own lives, leading to a better life for themselves, their families and community.

These funds have come together to give you the 'Give Inc Women's Fund'.

- assist with the cost of training programmes and course materials for women and girls building their confidence, life skills, education and employability.
